Description of the discussion and final decisions: **Lt. Colby informed the Board that Chief Mullen has opted to change from the position of Part-time Chief to Full-time Patrolman beginning June 1<sup>st</sup> as opposed to the original October date. Mullen will be at Step 17 Grade 9; \$22.10/hour with two weeks of vacation. With that change, Lt. Colby will be promoted to Chief of the Police Department. Lt. Colby asked that his rate**

of pay increase to Step 21 Grade 16; salaried at \$73,597.40 annually. Corporal Hayford will be promoted to Sargent and Lt. Colby asked that Hayford's rate of pay be increased to Step 20 Grade 13; salaried at \$61,068.93 annually.

Lt. Colby asked that the rate of pay for part-time patrolmen be increased to \$23.00 per hour. Those shifts will be used to cover mostly vacations.

Lt. Colby assured the Board that these changes will not cause the department to go over budget. The shifts in positions and salaries will still remain within budget. The Board unanimously agreed to the position and salary changes. These changes will begin with the 05/28/17 pay period.

Lt. Colby stated that on June 1<sup>st</sup> there will be a swearing in and a notice of the changes will be published in the paper. J. Shackford suggested to do a swearing in at a Selectmen's meeting. The Board decided on May 30<sup>th</sup> as the date.

Note: RSA 91-A:3(II) Minutes of proceedings in nonpublic session shall be kept and the record of all actions shall be promptly made available for public inspection, except as provided in this section. Minutes and decisions reached in nonpublic session shall be publicly disclosed within 72 hours of the meeting, unless, by recorded vote of 2/3 of the members present, it is determined that divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of the body or agency itself or render the proposed action ineffective. In the event of such circumstances, information may be withheld until, in the opinion of a majority of members, the aforesaid circumstances no longer apply.
