ARTICLES

Article II: Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$6,061,499? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$6,057,250, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the School District or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 5-0). (The Budget Committee recommends this appropriation 6-0).

Article III: Shall the voters of Madison School District adopt a school administrative unit budget of \$850,583 for the 2016-2017 school year in which \$237,419 is assigned to the school budget of this district? (The School Board recommends this appropriation 5-0). (The Budget Committee recommends this appropriation 6-0).

This year's adjusted budget of \$843,311 with \$234,903 assigned to the School District budget will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the district voters voting in this administrative unit.

Article IV: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$27,000 to be added to the previously established Bus Capital Reserve Fund. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 5-0). (The Budget Committee recommends this appropriation 6-0).
