

# TOWN of MADISON FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

## Article I - Prohibitions:

No person shall sell, display, set off or cause to be set off any fireworks within the Town of Madison.

## Article II - Exceptions:

Only those licensed commercial fireworks companies are allowed to display, set off or cause to set off fireworks as approved by the Commissioner of Safety for the State of New Hampshire. A permit must first be obtained as per RSA 160-B:3. Only Class B fireworks will be set off. The permit must have the approval of the Fire Chief and Police Chief and must be sought at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date the event is to take place.

## Article III - Violations and Penalties:

Any person found in violation of this ordinance will be fined no less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a first offense and no less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for a second or subsequent offense. All fireworks in violation of this ordinance will be confiscated.

## Article IV - Enforcement:

Any sworn law enforcement officer of the Town, State or County, as well as any fire officer of the Town or State is empowered to enforce this ordinance.

## Article V - Effective:


Pursuant to RSA 154:18, this ordinance was posted in 2 public places on May 25, 2005, and will therefore be effective on June 25, 2005.
