

## TRANSFERRING CURRENT REGISTRATION & PLATES TO A DIFFERENT VEHICLE

DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES requires owner's current registration from vehicle traded or sold to be sent to the DMV by Town Clerk at the time of completing the transfer. (RSA 261:66)

FIRST OWNER on CURRENT registration MUST also be  
FIRST OWNER on NEW registration, except for leased vehicles.

If no **BLUE NH Certificate of Title Application** from a NH Dealer on 2000 or newer vehicles,

**ALL OWNERS MUST BE PRESENT** to sign a NH CTA **OR**  
produce a **notarized** Power of Attorney form—obtainable at Town Clerk's  
office or Town website [www.madison-org](http://www.madison-org) and select Departments—Town  
Clerk—Motor Vehicle and Registration—DMV – Power of Attorney Form for  
Vehicle Transactions ONLY
