Cardboard at NCR: We think NCR is paying \$20 per ton for cardboard but we need to confirm and then check with NCIS. Still need a cover for the container if we go with NCR.

Non-Resident Coupons: Dave to get wording changes to Linda for the web site and the transfer station flyer.

Compactor: Paul and Chuck to follow up on getting info and a quote on a new compactor. Bob has info on state contacts for used equipment.

2017 Objectives: Dave to meet with Regan Pride of the North Country Council.

OTHER NEW BUSINESS OR MEMBER'S "LIST" ITEMS:

- Paul will be covering hazardous waste day in Conway again this year.
- Propane tanks can now be put in with the scrap metal NCR says. They just request that we put them on top of the pile so that they can pick them off and compromise them easily.
- Tins cans can be placed in the scrap metal. We should get a container to put them in like a large trash can or two so that people would not have to reach over the roll-off.

- We should look into glass crushing at Wolfboro. See if it might be cheaper to transport it there rather than bring in a crusher.
- It was noted that next year the BoS will be hiring a new Road Agent. It was suggested that since the transfer station reports to the road agent that there should be representation from the transfer station of SWAC on the selection committee. Bob will keep that in mind when the time comes.
