## **VOTER REGISTRATION FAQ's**

QUESTION	ANSWER
When and where are elections held?	Polls are opened from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Madison Elementary School in the Noyes Hall located at 2069 Village Road (Route 113)
How do I obtain an absentee ballot?	Complete an Absentee Ballot Request form. Click here.
What are the requirements to register to vote?	IDENTITY: A person must prove identity to establish that the evidence used to prove age, citizenship, and domicile relate to the applicant, such as Driver's License with imprinted Madison address or valid passport. Click here for additional information.
	AGE: A person must be 18 years of age by or on the day of the election;
	CITIZENSHIP: A person must be a citizen of the United States. Naturalization papers may be requested of a naturalized citizen. If Naturalization papers are not available, a qualified voter affidavit may be completed;
When can I register to vote?	DOMICILE: A person must have a domicile in Madison, NH. Supervisors require proof of domicile in the form of an affidavit declaring that the applicant has a domicile in Madison, NH. At Town Hall in the Clerk's Office during regular business hours, special sessions of the Supervisors of the Checklist (which are held prior to any election or meeting for which times and dates are published in local newspapers and posted at Town Hall) or at any election where officials are elected (same day voter registration).
	NOTE: Same day voter registration permitted at any town/school election (NOT at town meeting or school deliberative session).
When is the Voter Registration Cut Off?	No one may register after the <b>last meeting</b> of the Supervisors of the Checklist before the election (10 days prior to the election), which allows time to correct and print the checklists or as posted prior to a State Election.
