ARTICLE 2: Shall the Madison School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$7,110,576? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$7,020,176, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the School District or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 4-0-0.) (The Budget Committee does recommend this appropriation 7-0-0.)

ARTICLE 3: Shall the voters of the Madison School District adopt a school administrative unit budget of \$1,331,961 for the 2024-2025 school year in which \$467,389 is assigned to the school budget of this district? (The School Board recommends this appropriation 3-1-0.) (The Budget Committee does recommend this appropriation 5-0-2.)

This year's adjusted budget of \$1,055,505 with \$369,275 assigned to the School District budget will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the district voters voting in this administrative unit.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Madison School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000 to be placed in the previously established Special Education Capital Reserve Fund. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 4-0-0.) (The Budget Committee does recommend this appropriation 7-0-0.)

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Madison School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000 to be placed in the previously established Building Capital Reserve Fund. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 4-0-0.) (The Budget Committee does recommend this appropriation 7-0-0.)

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Madison School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to \$50,000 to be placed in the previously established Building Capital Reserve Fund, with such amount to be funded from the June 30 unreserved fund balance. (The School Board recommends this appropriation 4-0-0.) The Budget Committee does recommend this appropriation 7-0-0.)
