

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **January 19th to February 1st**

Sunday, January 19th: Called out at 7:00 a.m. to sand the transfer station. Came out at 8:00 p.m. for snow event.

Monday, January 20th: We were out plowing sanding and salting until 1:30 in the afternoon.

Tuesday, January 21st: Worked on truck 12 wiring issue and installed tool box on truck 12. Sanded icy spots on roads. Got two loads of salt delivered, approximately 66 tons. 1 trip to Mount Carberry.

Wednesday, January 22nd: Worked on getting 416 backhoe started. Repaired broken mailbox. Installed temperature road watch in truck 9 and 12. 1 trip to Mount Carberry. Cleaned office at lower garage.

Thursday, January 23rd: Fueled up 420 backhoe and fuel tank at transfer station. Got 416 backhoe running. Wired road temp sensor on truck 9. Installed plow lights on truck 14. Worked on CIP. Phone conference with NRR. Scheduled vehicle maintenance. Worked on iWorq.

Friday, January 24th: Loaded trucks for sanding roads. Sanded roads and washed truck 9 inside and out.

Monday, January 27th: Worked on calibrating truck 9 pre-wet system. Worked on prepping grader plow for painting. Took truck 9 to Lancaster for recall. Truck 2 service and clean.

Tuesday, January 28th: Worked in garage painting plow for grader and spinner on truck 9. 1 trip to Mount Carberry. Worked on iWorq.

Wednesday, January 29th: Plowed snow 5:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Thursday, January 30th: Checked roads and worked on broken bed chain on truck 10. Replaced broken pin on truck 14 plow. Cleaned truck 3 and 10. Loaded all trucks with sand. 1 trip to Mount Carberry and then serviced and cleaned truck 2.

Friday, January 31st: Swapped containers at transfer station and washed truck. Replaced broken bed chain on truck 10. Pumped septic tanks at upper and lower garage. Took truck 1 to DiPrizio's to get key switch fixed.

Saturday, February 1st: Plowed snow from 4:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.
