

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **February 2nd to February 15th**

Sunday, February 2nd: OFF

Monday, February 3rd: Plowed snow and sanded roads. Pushed back banks. 3:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Repaired wiring on truck 12.

Tuesday, February 4th: Sanded roads and pushed snowbanks back with grader. Repaired toggle switch on truck 12.

Wednesday, February 5th: Pushed snow back with grader and loader. Sanded roads with truck 14. Repaired plow chain hooks on truck 3.

Thursday, February 6th: Plowed snow and sanded roads. 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m.

Friday, February 7th: Plowed and sanded roads. Cleanup after storm.

Saturday, February 8th: OFF

Sunday, February 9th: Plowed snow and sanded roads from 3:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.

Monday, February 10th: Pushed snow banks back on the east Madison route with the CAT140 grader. Pushed back snow banks on the 41 route with truck 9 and the loader. Mailbox repair on Allard hill.

Tuesday, February 11th: Continued pushing back snow banks on every route using the CAT 140 grader, truck 9, truck 14, CAT 920 and CAT 420

Wednesday, February 12th: Pushed back Cul de sacs with CAT 420. Worked in the garage installing CB radio in truck 2 so to communicate with Mt. Carberry when trash hauling. Installed new wing arm on truck 9. Put a new cutting edge on the CAT 420

Thursday, February 13th: Plowed snow from 0500-1800

Friday, February 14th: Started on a trip to Mt. Carberry but had they had to close the landfill for the day due to high winds. Pushed banks back on George chick and Danforth Lane with CAT 140, pushed back Cul de sacs with CAT 920

Saturday, February 15th: Call out at 2300 for the start of the weekend long winter storm.
