

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **February 16th to March 1st**

Sunday, February 16th: We were already out plowing snow and we stayed out plowing all day. 24 hours.

Monday, February 17th: Presidents Day Holiday. We were out plowing from previous day and were out until 9:30 a.m. Took truck 2 to Bow N.H. for radio repair.

Tuesday, February 18th: Two trips to Mount Carberry. Worked on truck 12 plow spring and trip edge. Pushed snowbanks back with 920 and 420. Fixed hydraulic hose on truck 10 and installed road watch on truck 9.

Wednesday, February 19th: One trip to Mount Carberry. Cleaned and detailed truck 2. Pushed snowbanks back with truck 11 and 420 backhoe. Cleaned snow out of intersections and cul-de-sacs with 920 loader and pushed back snowbanks with 140 grader and cleaned up behind grader with truck 3.

Thursday, February 20th: One trip to Eco-Maine. Applied Wax-Oyl on truck 12 and finished fixing plow on truck 12. Fixed hydraulic hose on truck 14. Cleaned lower garage and washed truck 11.

Friday, February 21st: Dave covered at transfer station.

Monday, February 24th: Checked all roads. Pushed back snow banks with grader and truck three. Removed snow put in driveways with loader. Got new hose for pressure washer, the old one blew apart. We are getting the old one repaired. Two trips to Mount Carberry.

Wednesday, February 26th: Lower garage work and worked on power point presentation. Purchased rubber edge and swapped plows on truck 3 and truck 10. Worked on cable tower on truck 14.

Thursday, February 27th: Plowed snow from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 p.m. (13.5 hours)

Friday, February 28th: Pushed snowbanks back with 140 grader. Cleaned guardrails on Peak Vista with loader. Cleaned parking lots with 920 loader. Pushed snowbanks back with truck 14.

Saturday, March 1st: Plowed snow, sanded and salted from 5:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. (5.5 hours)
