

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **March 16th to March 29th**

Sunday, March 16th:

Monday, March 17th: Heavy rains the previous night caused significant washout on Pound Road. Used road grader and Volvo excavator and three trucks to reconstruct road. Put 146.84 tons of 3" crushed stone, 88.85 tons of 1-1/2" crushed gravel and 12.22 tons of 1-1/2" crushed stone on road to rebuild. Cleaned out one driveway culvert that was plugged.

Tuesday, March 18th: Finished unclogging culvert on Pound Road with fire truck and calcium. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry. Raked roads with front rake to try and smooth out and dry out. Checked broken lamp post in the meadows. Brought truck #10 to Allegiant Truck in Barrington for a recall.

Wednesday, March 19th: Hauled stone to North Division and placed in soft muddy spots and smoothed over with grader. Hauled stone to Old Colony Road and Salter Hill Road and placed in muddy spots and raked out. Hauled 3" stone from Colemans to stockpile at garage. Worked on fixing broken York rake. One trip to Eco-Maine and worked on Annual Facility Report for transfer station. Brought 420 Backhoe to Frechette tire for new rear tires.

Thursday, March 20th: Picked up 420 back hoe from Frechette Tire after they replaced rear tires. Cleaned off catch basins on North Division and pulled beaver screen. Put plow and sander grates back on trucks 9 and 12. Fixed broken push arms on front rake. Serviced truck 2. Hauled 6 loads of 3" minus crushed stone back to garage for stockpile. Made new brackets for York rake. Repaired a trash container door. Completed Annual Facility Report and turned into Town Administrator Linda Shackford.

Friday, March 21st: Put plows on small trucks and put plow and sander back in truck 14. Put York rake back together. Put gear oil in truck 10 because it had a bad rear wheel seal. Checked roads.

Monday, March 24th: Plowed snow 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. 15 hours

Tuesday, March 25th: Wired new lights on truck 3. Plowed and sanded north route and cleaned truck 11. Checked roads and sanded and met with pavers for bid. Took truck ten to Hilton's truck repair to fix rear wheel seal. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry.

Wednesday, March 26th: Worked around the shop. Put new mirrors on truck 11. 1 Trip to Harding Metals in Northwood. 1 Trip to Mount Carberry. Met with Pike for paving Bid.

Thursday, March 27th: Two trips to Mount Carberry. Put stone in pot holes on North Division and Edelweiss Drive with grader and truck 9.

Friday, March 28th: Cleaned and serviced truck 2 and had zoom meeting iWorq. Prepared trucks for upcoming storm.

Saturday, March 29th: Plowed snow from 5:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. 8.5 hours

NOTE: We are now taking our light iron and aluminum to Harding Metals in Northwood instead of having Ricker's pick it up. Current pricing with Harding for light iron is \$138 per ton and aluminum is \$0.91 per pound. We were getting \$50 per ton for light iron and \$0.32 per pound for aluminum from Ricker's.
