

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **March 30th to April 12th**

Sunday, March 30th: Snow, ice and freezing rain. Treating roads from 7:30 until 11:00 a.m.

Monday, March 31st: Ordered a load of road salt. Ordered parts for CAT 920 loader. Cleaned out sander in truck 3 and cleaned out the body. Checked culverts and catch basins to make sure rain was getting into them. Scanned computer on truck 10 to see the reason of the check engine light.

Tuesday, April 1st: Repaired hydraulic coupling on truck 2 and then made 2 trips to Mt. Carberry. Used truck 3 with the front rake to rake the dirt roads to help fill in the potholes the best we can until we can grade the roads. Complete service on truck 10.

Wednesday, April 2nd: EWR140 excavator to pull beaver screen on Lead Mine Road because of high water from the beavers clogging the screen. Raked dirt roads on the North Division side of town with truck 3. Put a complete coat of wax on the CAT 140 grader. Put plow back on truck 3 at the end of the day to be ready for overnight storm. 1 trip to Mount Carberry. Cleaned truck 2. Cleaned up taxpayer sand area.

Thursday, April 3rd: Call out at 0430, heavy sleeting covering the roads, scraped and treated all paved roads and scraped off the dirt roads when they became slushy due to the heavy rain. Installed water cooler in lower garage and cleaned lower garage.

Friday, April 4th: Installed and wired replacement amber strobe lights on truck 9. Washed and cleaned trucks, met with Hurteau heating about the installation of the new furnace at the lower garage the following week. Brought code car to Hilton's for repair.

Monday, April 7th: Graded and raked out North Division Road with 140 grader and truck 3. Washed truck 1 and applied a coat of wax to it. Filled in potholes with cold patch on East Shore Drive, West Shore Drive, East Madison Rd, Horseleg Hill and Forrest Pines Rd. Fixed center bolt on truck 10 rubber edge plow. Picked up code car from Hilton's truck repair. Removed broken furnace from lower garage for the new furnace to be installed in the morning. Hauled 1 load to Mt. Carberry. Picked up Code car from Hilton's.

Tuesday, April 8th: Checked roads, cleaned shop. iWorq data entry and met with NAPA representative.

Wednesday, April 9th: Graded and raked out Salter Hill Road. Worked on all mowers getting them ready for spring. Put together parts list for JD 3033R, JD zero turn and Gravely zero turn. Picked up parts at United Ag & Turf. Took mowers and tractor out of winter storage. Two trips to Mount Carberry.

Thursday, April 10th: Graded and raked Savary Road. Dave worked on iWorq, invoices and fuel log entries. Repaired grill on 920 loader and cleaned 920.

Friday, April 11th: Removed front wing tower from grader. Staked out area at Transfer Station for concrete pad. Worked on iWorq.

Saturday, April 12th: Plowed and salted from snow storm from 10:00 until 2:00. 4 hours
