

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **April 13th to April 26th**

Sunday, April 13th:

Monday, April 14th: Took mud season road postings down. Two trips to Mount Carberry. Graded Winter Road, Charlotte Point Road, Mooney Hill to Pound Road. Raked all aforementioned roads with truck 3 and front rake. Washed trucks

Tuesday, April 15th: Graded Colby Hill Road and Modoc Hill Road. Raked Lead Mine Road lower end to East Shore Drive. Raked Colby Hill and Modoc Hill after graded with truck 3 and front rake. Pulled out wood chipper and went thru it. Cut rusted fenders off and ordered new ones. One trip to Mount Carberry. Spring cleaning at Head of the Lake, Foot of the Lake and Lyman and Gilman Cemetery. Put new plugs in all lawn mowers.

Wednesday, April 16th: Graded Eidelweiss Drive, Island Drive, Brenner Drive and Pound Road. Raked all aforementioned roads with truck 3 and front rake. Removed down tree on East Madison Road. Cleaned up around Town Hall with John Deere Tractor. Hauled compost from Transfer Station to Town Garage and pushed up with loader.

Thursday, April 17th: Graded Lead Mine Road. Went to McLeans in Limerick to look at flatbed for truck 11. Hauled more compost from Transfer Station to Garage. Trained Dave on Grader. Raked Lead Mine Road. Diagnosed truck 10 and ran it through regen cycle. Changed oil in all lawn mowers.

Friday, April 18th: Swept lower garage. Removed plows from all trucks that need to be painted or sandblasted.

Monday, April 21st: Received two brooms from Milton Rents. Opened Glines Hill Road for the summer. Swept Forest Pines Road, Pine Hill Road, Jones Road, Winter Road, Glines Hill, Maple Grove Road, Horseleg Hill Road, King Pine Road, Goe Hill Road and the Elementary School. Used water tank in the back of truck 3 for dust control. Received replacement fenders for chipper. Picked up 10 bags of sandblasting media at Coleman's to use on some of the older plows for repainting. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry.

Tuesday, April 22nd: Swept Saxon Road, Alexander Ave, Kingswood Circle, Moores Pond and ½ of West Shore and half of East Shore Drive with sweepers. Swept Fox Road, Pound Road, Mooney Hill Road, Colby Hill Road, Peak Vista, Boulder Road, Nacoma, Spruce Spur and the entrance to the Transfer Station with 920 loader with broom on it. Used truck 3 with water tank in back for dust control. Installed new fenders on Eager Beaver chipper. The old ones had rotted off. Cleaned and organized lower garage and built new battery box for chipper. Made two trips to Harding metals. One aluminum and one light iron. \$1,322.00 in revenue.

Wednesday, April 23rd: Finished sweeping East Shore and West Shore Drives. Swept all of Carved in Bark, Crossroad and the Madison section of Ossipee Lake Road, finished West View Drive. Used truck 3 with water tank to wet roads for dust control. Built pad and dug trench at Library for propane tank installation for generator. Cleaned debris off monument beach. 1 trip to Mount Carberry with Bulky Waste. Primed and painted fenders on Eager Beaver Chipper. Sand blasted, primed and painted wheels on Eager Beaver Chipper.

Thursday, April 24th: Swept all roads in Banfield hollow. One of the sweepers we rented from Milton Rents lost a bearing in the front wheel. Replaced it with a rental from Coleman's. Swept Town Line Road, Spigot Hill, Allard Hill, Ridgeview and the Meadows. We also swept the Transfer Station. We moved over to the other side of town and swept Danforth Lane, Greenwood Road and Greenwood Spur. Dave had a zoom meeting with iWorq. Finished putting chipper together. Used truck 3 for dust control with water tank.

Friday, April 25th: Swept High Street, Deer Drive and remaining parking lots. Used truck 3 for dust control
