

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **May 11th to May 24th**

Sunday, May 11th:

Monday, May 12th: Picked up catch basin cleaner from Milton Rents in Chichester. Graded Maple Grove Road and applied dust control. Finished putting new bristles on broom. Started taking truck 11 apart for new flatbed. Two trips to Mount Carberry. One bulky waste and one municipal Solid Waste. Cleaned Foot of the Lake beach. Picked rocks on Maple Grove Road. Inspected John Deere zero turn for oil leak.

Tuesday, May 13th: Cleaned catch basins at Town Hall and started on the ones on High Street. Worked on truck 11 and cleaning lower garage. Repaired culvert headwall on High Street. Cleaned up Foot of the Lake and mowed Gilman Cemetery.

Wednesday, May 14th: Cleaned catch basins on High Street. Took body off truck 11 and flipped over new flatbed and installed frame rails and primed. Took signs up to Pound Road in preparation for tree cutting. Two trips to Mount Carberry. Finished mowing Gilman Cemetery and mowed Lyman Cemetery.

Thursday, May 15th: Graded Glines Hill. Tree cutting on Pound Road. Finished cleaning catch basins. Sandblasted plow on truck 14 and frame of truck 11.

Friday, May 16th: Returned vacuum trailer to Milton Rents in Chichester. Mowed both upper and lower ballfields. One trip to Harding Metals in Northwood with scrap metal. Went to H.P. Fairfield to pick up new wings.

Monday, May 19th: Two trips to Mount Carberry, one municipal solid waste and one bulky waste. Mowed Kennett Park and Head of the Lake. Mowed Town Hall and lower ballfield. Weed wacked both ballfields. Cleaned ditches on North Division Road with grader, loader and truck 14. Primed truck 14 plow and truck 11 flatbed and truck 11 rear frame.

Tuesday, May 20th: Took 920 to Transfer Station for cleanup. One trip to Mount Carberry. Mowed Gilman Cemetery. Mowed upper ball field and school. Mowed Historical Society and sharpened mower blades. Finished ditching North Division Road then graded it and raked it and put down dust control. Painted on flatbed and truck 11.

Wednesday, May 21st: Weed wacked Gilman Cemetery. Graded Colby Hill Road and raked and applied dust control. Graded Lead Mine Road to Cooks Pond turn around. Loaded scrap Metal and made a trip to Harding Metals. Started building subframe on truck 11.

Thursday, May 22nd: Serviced and washed truck 2. Checked roads in preparation for long weekend. Finished welding flatbed on Truck 11.

Friday, May 23rd: Cleaned up lower garage.
