

## Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of:           **June 8<sup>th</sup> to June 21<sup>st</sup>**

### **Sunday, June 8<sup>th</sup>:**

**Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>:** Continued hammering ledge on Pound Road and hauled broken ledge back to town garage. Continued ditching on pound road and hauling the ditching material away. Finished putting flatbed on truck 11. Mowed Gilman Cemetery. Two loads were hauled to Mount Carberry, one M.S.W. and one bulky.

**Tuesday, June 10<sup>th</sup>:** Continued hammering ledge on Pound Road and hauling it back to the garage. Continued ditching on Pound Road and hauling ditching material away. Called Dig Safe in preparation of changing a failed culvert on Lead Mine Road. Weed wacked Gilman Cemetery. Cleaned out white trailer and sharpened 4 sets of lawn mower blades. Cut pavement at Transfer Station for ramp. 1 trip to Mount Carberry. Worked on truck 11 wiring harness and body lights.

**Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup>:** Graded and raked Winter Road, Charlotte Point and the end of Lead Mine Road. Put out swim lines at Head of the Lake, Foot of the Lake and Nichols Beach. Put out rafts at Foot of the Lake and Head of the Lake. Mowed both upper and lower ballfields. Hauled 8 loads of 6" erosion stone to garage from Coleman's for future use on Pound Road. Marked out dig safe location on Lead Mine Road. Wired parking lights on truck 11 flatbed. Pushed out pile of broken ledge at town garage.

**Thursday, June 12<sup>th</sup>:** Mowed Elementary school, Foot of the Lake, Head of the Lake Kennett Park and Town Hall. Pulled broken pieces from guardrail on Peak Vista. Pulled beaver screen on Lead Mine Road. Set calcium tank on truck 11.

**Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup>:** Changed oil in truck 1. Took trash to Transfer Station. Replaced oxygen and acetylene tanks for lower garage. Filled propane tank for transfer station. 1 trip to Mount Carberry with bulky waste.

**Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>:** Worked at Transfer Station.

### **Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>:**

**Monday, June 16<sup>th</sup>:** Mowed Lyman Cemetery, Historical Society, Library and upper ballfield. One trip to Northwood with scrap metal. Cleaned and serviced truck 2. Took tree down on Pound Road and finished hammering ledge. Continued ditching on Pound Road and digging out turnouts.

**Tuesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>:** Two trips were made to Mount Carberry, one bulky waste and one municipal solid waste. Picked up steel for truck 11 at Presby Steel. Continued ditching on Pound Road and hauling ditching material away. Cleaned all beaches. Weed wacked left corner of upper ballfield.

**Wednesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>:** Took truck 2 to Lancaster for transmission service and made one trip to Mount Carberry with bulky waste. Worked on truck 11 calcium tank mounting brackets. Continued ditching on Pound Road. Picked up branches at Gilman Cemetery. Sharpened and picked up new mower blades. Cut pine trees around upper ballfield. Mowed upper and lower ballfield.

**Thursday, June 19<sup>th</sup>:** Finished stiff arm brackets for calcium tank. Cleaned up tracks on 315 excavator and prepared it for return.

**Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup>:** Went to transfer station to swap containers. Drilled out tie down holes and prime strong arms for truck 11.
