

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **June 22nd to July 5th**

Sunday, June 22nd:

Monday, June 23rd: Extreme heat! Graded Eidelweiss Drive, Island Drive and some of Brenner Drive. Then put dust control down. Finished cleaning out ditch on lower half of Pound Road. Installed approximately 200 feet of underdrain and backfilled with 3-inch stone. Added reclaim gravel to shoulders and compacted with roller. Mowed Gilman Cemetery. Cleaned beaches.

Tuesday, June 24th: Extreme heat again! Graded Bickford Road. Finished cleaning out second section of ditch on Pound Road and then put down a stone base. Installed over 200 feet of underdrain and covered with more stone. Added gravel to the shoulder and graded and compacted. Mowed Head of the Lake and Foot of the Lake and Kennett Park beaches. Weed wacked Gilman cemetery. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry with Municipal Solid Waste.

Wednesday, June 25th: Not quite as hot today. Sprayed dust control on Bickford Road. Installed just over 300' of underdrain on Pound Rd. and filled with 3" stone. Hauled in 1 ½" reclaim gravel from stockpile at the garage to widen the road with the grader. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry with bulky waste. Cleaned beaches and mowed Town Hall and both ballfields.

Thursday, June 26th: Continued installing underdrain on Pound Road, approx. another 300' and backfilled with 3" stone. Hauled in more 1 ½" reclaim from stockpile to continue the road widening.

Friday, June 27th: Repaired broken U-bolt on front runner rake. Raked Pound Road for the weekend and then applied dust control.

Saturday, June 28th: Swapped container at Transfer Station.

Sunday, June 29th:

Monday, June 30th: Removed 2 failed culverts from Forest Pines Road, backfilled with 1 ½" gravel and compacted with the 5-ton roller. Began ditching on Forest Pines Road. Hauled 1 load of MSW to Mount Carberry and 1 Load to Harding metal totaling 5.9 tons of scrap metal. Cleaned beaches, mowed Head of the Lake. Put patch in Silver Lake Post Office parking lot. Made 1 trip to Mount Carberry with municipal solid waste and one trip to Harding Metals in Northwood with scrap metal.

Tuesday, July 1st: Three trips were made to Mount Carberry with bulky waste. Mowed the Elementary School, Lyman Cemetery and both ball fields. Ditched on Forest Pines preparing for next week's paving. Pike ground and graded Town Line Road.

Wednesday, July 2nd: Changed failed culvert on Forest Pines in preparation for paving. Cleaned beaches and put calcium flakes on Forest Pines for dust control.

Thursday, July 3rd: Pike Paved Town Line Road.
