

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **July 6th to July 19th**

Sunday, July 6th:

Monday, July 7th: Mowed Gilman Cemetery. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry. One with Municipal Solid Waste and one with Bulky Waste. Brought fuel to Transfer Station and greased excavator checked roads. Worked in lower garage on vehicle maintenance.

Tuesday, July 8th: Cleaned all beaches, fixed stop sign on East Madison Road. Repaired and replaced tire on landscaping trailer. Hauled on load of metal to Harding Metals with scrap iron and took one load of Municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry. Hauled $\frac{3}{4}$ ledge pack gravel from Colemans to shop in preparation for shouldering. Brought culvert to Lead Mine Road to replace the next day.

Wednesday, July 9th: Took one load of Municipal Solid Waste to Mount Carberry and returned to shop and serviced truck 2 L.O.F. Mowed town Hall and Kennett Park. Replaced culvert on Pound Road. Organized plows at shop.

Thursday, July 10th: Finished servicing and cleaning Truck 2. Hauled 3 inch minus stone from Colemans to stockpile at garage. Brought used oil storage barrel to Transfer Station. Mowed the end of Winter Road with excavator and fixed sign.

Friday, July 11th: Worked on grease dispenser on Volvo excavator and plugged pin hole in grease line.

Saturday, July 12th:

Sunday, July 13th: Called out for large tree down in road on East Shore Drive at intersection with Lead Mine Road. Got tree far enough off road so it was not obstructing traffic.

Monday, July 14th: Picked up road side mower at Coleman's. Picked up and chipped downed tree on East Shore Drive. Roadside mowing on Boulder Road, Spruce Spur and Nacomia Drive. Began shoulder graveling Forest Pines Road. Cleaned all beaches. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry. One with Municipal Solid Waste and one with Bulky Waste.

Tuesday, July 15th: Continued shoulder graveling Forest Pines Road. One trip was made to Mount Carberry with Bulky Waste. One trip was made to Harding Metals with scrap metal. Road side mowing on Peak Vista and Mooney Hill and started on Modoc Hill.

Wednesday, July 16th: Finished shoulder graveling Forest Pines Road. Finished roadside mowing on Modoc Hill and Modoc extension and started Glines Hill Road. One trip was made to Mount Carberry with Municipal solid Waste. Took one load of scrap metal to Rickers.

Thursday, July 17th: Put shoulder gravel out on Town Line Road. Finished roadside mowing Glines Hill Road, Downs Road and started Bickford Road.

Friday, July 18th: Worked on roller attachment for 3033.
