

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **July 20th to August 2nd**

Sunday, July 20th: Called out after heavy wind and rain storm to remove some trees from the road. Checked all roads.

Monday, July 21st: Cleaned beaches. Swim Line a Foot of the Lake was broken. Cut and chipped down trees from prior days storm on Maple Grove Road and Danforth Lane. Mowed upper and lower ballfields. Mowed Town Hall. Sharpened mower blades. Made two trips to Mount Carberry. One with municipal solid waste and one with bulky waste.

Tuesday, July 22nd: Graded North Division Road, Old Colony Road and Salter Hill Road. We then raked all those roads and then added magnesium for dust Control. Roadside mowing on Old Colony Road, Savary Road and began on Salter Hill Road. Repaired swim line at Foot of the Lake. Changed out mower blades. Brought scrap metal to Transfer Station. Ordered fuel tank for Gravely lawn mower; original tank had crack in it and was leaking gas. Road side mowing on North Division Road. Removed and replaced failed culvert on Maple Grove Road.

Wednesday, July 23rd: Graded Pound Road and added gravel to thin areas of the road. We then raked it out and added magnesium for dust control. Placed 6-inch erosion stone in ditch line on Maple Grove Road. Road side mowing on North Division Road. Cleaned Beaches. Mowed Head of the Lake, Kennett Park and Lyman Cemetery. Road side mowing on North Division Road.

Thursday, July 24th: Mowed Foot of the Lake. Finished roadside mowing on North Division Road and all roads off North Division Road. 1 trip was made to Mount Carberry with bulky waste and 1 trip was made to Harding Metals with scrap metal. Cleaned up upper garage. Performed a service on truck 12, lube oil and filters. Put 6" rip-rap and 3' minus stone in ditches on Pound Road.

Friday, July 25th: Called in for flat tire at transfer station on 420 backhoe and swapped container while there. Removed tailings pile from back of sand pile in preparation for screening winter sand. Received screen for screening winter sand.

Monday, July 28th: Cleaned all Beaches. Changed Batteries in truck 10. Mowed Gilman Cemetery. Cleaned up around fire station. Removed bushes and brought in stone and installed new drip edge. Roadside mowing, finished Bickford Road and Mooney Hill Road. Graded tasker Hill Road and then applied dust control. Screened winter sand all day. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry, both with municipal solid waste.

Tuesday, July 29th: Mowed and weed wacked Gilman Cemetery. Fixed broken spring on John Deere zero turn. Roadside mower broke down. Worked on mower for a time trying to diagnose the problem. Inevitably it had to be taken to Colemans for repair. Checked all roads and dug sand out of bank for screening. Screened sand all day. Two trips were made to Mount Carberry, both with bulky waste.

Wednesday, July 30th: Cleaned beaches. Mowed school and library. Weed wacked Town Hall. Graded Glines Hill Road and then raked it and applied dust control. Hauled 6" and 3" minus stone to Pound Road to put in the ditch. Started cleaning up around garage in preparation for Old Home Week. One trip was made to Mount Carberry with municipal solid waste and one trip was made to Harding Metals with scrap metal. Screened sand all day.

Thursday, July 31st: Cleaned up around garage in preparation for Old Home Week. Graded parking lot and Justin gave Dave some operator training. Bush hogged, weed wacked and mowed around property. Screened sand all day.

Friday, August 1st: Pushed up screened sand tailings pile out back and made a ramp to the back of the pile. Dug out more sand with the excavator for next week's screening.
