

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **August 31st to September 13th**

Sunday, August 31st:

Monday, September 1st: Labor Day Holiday

Tuesday, September 2nd: Roadside mowing on East Madison Road. Checked culverts all around town. Pushed up piles of aggregate in back of garage. Patched potholes on East Shore Drive. Cleaned all beaches and removed remaining swim lines for season. Hauled two loads of municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry.

Wednesday, September 3rd: Roadside Mowing on East Madison Road. Hauled $\frac{3}{4}$ ledge pack gravel from Colemans to Pound Road and gate spread it out. Graded it out with the 140 Cat Grader and then applied magnesium for dust control. Met with Bruce Davis from Allstate asphalts to measure and check roads for possible Chip Seal treatment. Mowed Lyman Cemetery and Head of the Lake. Hauled two loads of bulky waste to Mount Carberry.

Thursday, September 4th: Roadside mowing on East Madison Road. Received complaint of a culvert on Forest Pines Road of opening too deep and too close to the edge of road. Caller believed it to be a safety hazard. We went up and added 3" stone and placed delineator posts on both inlet and outlet of culvert. Mowed Foot of the Lake and Kennett Park. Fixed truck 9. The back door on the tailgate was bent and was leaking aggregate when loaded. Took truck 2 to ATG in Lancaster to get serviced and check error codes.

Friday, September 5th: Fixed air leaks on truck 10.

Monday, September 8th: Roadside mowing on East Madison Road and Fox Road. Put shoulder gravel out on Forest Pines and Jones Hill cul-de-sacs with excavator and compacted with roll. Fixed Headwall that had fallen over in a culvert on Old Colony Road. Dug a large rock out of road on Danforth Lane and temporarily filled with gravel. It will be repaved in the near future. Cleaned all Beaches. Mowed upper ballfield and around it. Picked up Brush cutter heads for weed whackers. Two loads were hauled to Mount Carberry. One with municipal solid waste and one with bulky waste.

Tuesday, September 9th: Roadside mowing on East Shore Drive. Started ditching on George Chick Drive. Started weed whacking knot weed on Town Line Road for line of sight. Had to stop because of ground hornets. Weed whacked around ballfields and fill school path behind lower garage with stone. Hauled one load of bulky waste to Mount Carberry and then serviced and cleaned truck 2.

Wednesday, September 10th: Roadside mowing on East Shore Drive. Continued ditching on George Chick Dr. Weed whacked around bridges on East Madison Road. Weed Whacked around lower garage. Weed whacked around batting cages and under bleachers. Cut bushes and cleaned up stonewall around lower

level of town hall. Hauled one load of municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry and then took one load of scrap metal to Harding Metals in Northwood.

Thursday, September 11th: Roadside mowing on west shore drive. Brought mower back to garage and cleaned for pickup. Transferred waste oil at transfer station. Marked out places around town to saw cut for paving next week. Worked on truck 14.
