

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **September 14th to September 27th**

Sunday, September 14th:

Monday, September 15th: Two SPW employees received routine drug testing for their Commercial Drivers Licenses. The failed metal culvert at the bottom of George Chick Drive was removed and then replaced with 40 feet of HDPE culvert. The inlet and outlet of the culvert was stone lined. The culvert was laid in sand and backfilled with new ¾" crushed gravel and then compacted. Cut Brush at Gilman Cemetery. Pulled in raft at Foot of The Lake. Trimmed brush on bridge on East Madison Road. One load of Municipal Solid Waste was hauled to Mount Carberry.

Tuesday, September 16th: Hauled two loads of stone from Burke Quarry for the ditches on George Chick Drive. Worked in lower garage. Hauled two loads of bulky waste to Mount Carberry and then greased truck 2. Measured spots around town for paving later. Trimming brush at Gilman Cemetery. Mowed with mini excavator around town properties. Hauled raft from Foot of the Lake with loader up onto beach and put away for winter. Mowed Town Hall. Cut brush with mini excavator on Danforth Lane.

Wednesday, September 17th: Ditched George Chick Drive and Marjorie Chick Lane with grader and hauled away ditching. Mowed on Danforth Lane with mini excavator. One municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry. High limbed George and Marjorie Chick Lane. Sprayed dust control on George and Marjorie Chick Lane. One load of Municipal Solid Waste was taken to Mount Carberry. Cut brush along fences on Peak Vista Lane. Cut brush at Gilman Cemetery. Roadside mowing on Danforth Lane with mini excavator.

Thursday, September 18th: Paved Transfer Station. Measured Deer Drive for future paving work. Roadside mowing and brush cutting on Danforth Lane.

Friday, September 19th: Paved Danforth Lane where we had removed boulders a week ago. Removed rocks on Winter Road. Prepped pad at Town Hall for paving. Roadside mowing and brush cutting on Danforth Lane.

Monday, September 22nd: Cut out pavement on East Shore Drive, Fawn Drive and Doe Drive where it had broken away. Removed old pavement and laid in new pavement. Cleaned Beaches

Tuesday, September 23rd: Swept pavement with 920 loader on Danforth Lane, Greenwood, Heritage Lane, Forest Pines and Jones Hill. Got pad at garage ready for paving. Repaired hydraulic hose on paver.

Wednesday, September 24th: Paved pad at town garage for a place to put hot mix in winter. Paved entrances to lower garage so our plow frames wouldn't hit going in and out. Cleaned paver and roll for

return. One Bulky Waste and one Municipal Solid Waste was taken to Mount Carberry. Contacted Presby R & D for dumpster pricing for Town Hall.

Thursday, September 25th: One light iron and one aluminum can container was taken to Harding Metals in Northwood. Worked on changing and rebuilding plow frame on truck 14.

Friday, September 26th: Hauled 3-inch stone to George Chick Drive and stone lined ditches. Blew leaves and debris out of George and Marjorie Chick and then graded. Added one load of 3/4" gravel to top. Fixed sinkhole on Fox Road. Worked in lower garage on truck 14 plow frame and cleaning.
