

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **September 28th to October 11th**

Sunday, September 28th:

Monday, September 29th: One load of bulky waste and one load of municipal solid waste was hauled to Mount Carberry. Hauled 5 loads of ¾" crushed gravel from Colemans to shop stockpile. Brought truck 14 to Hilton's Heavy Truck Repair for annual inspection. Put dock in at Foot of Lake. Removed Branch on Jones Hill Road. Limbed Danforth Lane. Cleaned up yard with 920 loader and pushed up gravel stockpile.

Tuesday, September 30th: One load of bulky waste and one load of municipal solid waste was hauled to Mount Carberry. Fixed washout on side of East Madison Road with EWR150. Got flat tire on EWR150. Removed tire and brought to Frechette tire for repair. Trimmed brush behind Fire Station. Trimmed brush at Gilman Cemetery. Removed brush from Nichols Beach culvert. Worked on truck 14 plow frame and wing tower.

Wednesday, October 1st: Patched several potholes on Horseleg Hill Road. Cleaned and serviced truck 2. Finished wing tower on truck 14.

Thursday, October 2nd: Repaired rear light latch on 140. Changed cutting edge on 140 grader. Worked in lower garage.

Friday, October 3rd: Marked culverts on East Madison Road with posts and reflectors. Patched potholes on East Madison Road.

Saturday, October 4th: Called out by Madison Police at approximately 11:00 P.M. for a large tree down across Lead Mine Road prohibiting travel. Responded to location with four people the 920 loader and chain saws. Removed tree from road.

Sunday, October 5th:

Monday, October 6th: Picked up truck 14 from Hilton's Truck Repair in Conway after getting state inspection. Pulled ditches on Modoc Hill Road with 140 Grader. Loaded out ditching with 920 loader, into trucks 14 and 9 and hauled away. Mowed upper and lower ballfields and sharpened blades on mowers. Checked and cleaned all beaches. One bulky waste and one municipal solid waste was hauled to Mount Carberry.

Tuesday, October 7th: Continued pulling ditches Modoc Hill Road and Modoc Hill Ext. with 140 Motor Grader. Picked up ditching material with 920 loader and hauled away with trucks 9 and 12. One bulky waste and one municipal solid waste was hauled to Mount Carberry. Put tires back on EWR150.

Wednesday, October 8th: One municipal solid waste load was hauled to Mount Carberry and one load of light iron was taken to Northwood. Took one row of logs out of dam on Silver Lake. Blew leaf's off Colby Hill Road in preparation for grading. Graded Colby Hill Road and then raked it out with truck 3. Checked roads.

Thursday, October 9th: Removed a set of boards on the dam. Finished ditching Modoc Hill Road. Removed rusted oil pan from truck 12.

Friday, October 10th: Checked Roads. Reinstalled rocks around mulch pile behind Town Hall. Prepped and installed graphics on new Police Department cruiser.
