

Summary of work performed by the Madison Department of Public Works between the dates of: **December 7th to December 20th**

Sunday, December 7th: Covered the transfer station.

Monday, December 8th: Came out at 0430 to plow and sand after small snowstorm. Put the barriers up on Glines Hill Road to close it for the winter with the 920 loader, also picked rocks out of the ditches on Downs Road and Bickford Road that had fallen from the stone walls. Covered the transfer station from 6:00 a.m. until noon. Took one load of Bulky waste to Mount Carberry.

Tuesday, December 9th: Worked in the garage on truck 3 issues. Fixed taillight wiring on drivers' side on truck 14 and replaced two hydraulic hoses on truck 12's front wing tower and prepped trucks for upcoming snow storm. Hauled two loads of municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry.

Wednesday, December 10th: Plowed and sanded roads from 0700 to 0100 Thursday morning. Approximately of 7 inches of snow.

Thursday, December 11th: Came back in at 0430 to cleanup storm and get roads sanded for the buses. Plowed and cleaned up transfer station.

Friday, December 12th: Covered the transfer station. Put a new cutting edge on truck 11's plow. Sanded all dirt roads and plowed drifts from the wind.

Saturday, December 13th:

Sunday, December 14th: Called out at 1300 hours for snow storm, plowed and sanded roads until 1730 hours. Approximately 2 to 3" snow storm.

Monday, December 15th: Came in early at 0530 to get roads sanded for bus traffic. Put new solid wing block on truck 9's wing. Fixed rear spinner bracket on truck 9 and installed the rear spinner. Worked on truck 10's passenger side headlight connection that is causing the headlight not to work. Diagnosed truck 3 transmission module and kept building garage stairs. Hauled one load of municipal solid waste to Mount Carberry.

Tuesday, December 16th: Took fuel to the transfer station along with trash and cardboard from the town hall and lower garage. Worked on truck 10's wing arms making new knuckles and straightening the wing bracket. Finished putting the railing on the stairs in the upper garage and continued to try to diagnose truck 3 issue. One load of bulky waste was taken to Mount Carberry and one load of aluminum was taken to Harding's.

Wednesday, December 17th: Repaired sander on truck 14, changing hoses on spinner. Opened up all catch basins around town preparing for upcoming rain. Finished garage stairs. Looked up parts in preparation for John Deere zero turn engine removal. Hauled one municipal solid waste to Carberry and serviced truck 2.

Thursday, December 18th: Sanded all dirt roads in preparation for upcoming rain.

Friday, December 19th: Came out at 3:30 a.m. for extremely icy road conditions. Treated all roads. Went home at 12:30 p.m.. Worked on Iworq fuel log data.
